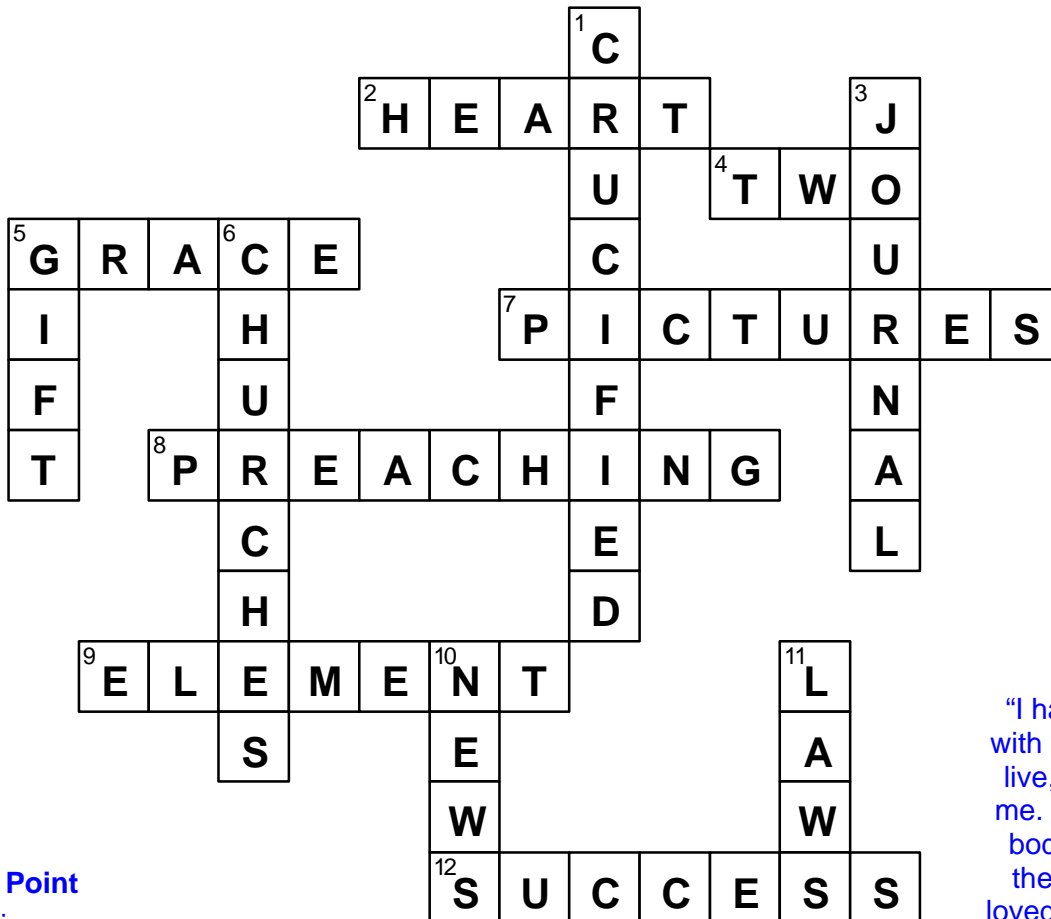

- 2. Being crucified with Christ means I have asked Him to come & live in my \_\_\_\_\_. And when He comes, He changes me into a different kind of person.
- 4. That's the situation in the first \_\_\_\_\_ chapters of the book of Galatians.

- 7. [Friday's lesson] Ask to look at family \_\_\_\_\_. Notice how members of your family have changed over time.
- 8. This meeting convinced the other leaders of the church that Paul was indeed a new creature in Christ Jesus. "They saw I had been entrusted with the task of \_\_\_\_\_ the gospel to the Gentiles, ... God ... was also at work in my ministry as an apostle to the Gentiles.
- 9. Grace. The same \_\_\_\_\_ that saves us from sin changes lives. The other apostles see the difference grace has made in Paul's life.
- 10. The word "gospel" means good \_\_\_\_\_, & the good \_\_\_\_\_ is that Jesus' death saves us from our sins. Depending on old laws of festivals, sacrifices, & circumcision is not good \_\_\_\_\_ at all in Paul's estimation. It is not grace!
- 11. Paul explains how he had zealously kept the \_\_\_\_\_, to the point of murdering Christians in an effort to destroy the church. But then "God . . . called me by his grace" (verse 15).
