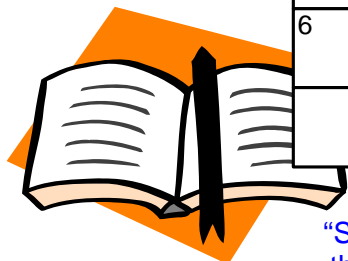
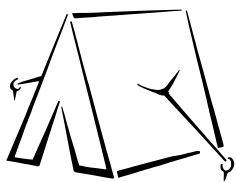


# Lesson 01 - The Boy & the Ram
