**Power Text**

FTWTF means: Find The Word That Fits

- [Monday's lesson] Read 2 Kings 12:1-8. Look for a small can, cup, or \_\_\_\_ that you can keep in your room as a special container-like the chest in the story of King Joash-to place your tithe & offerings in before you take them to church. Decorate your special container to make it look as nice as you can.
- At last work begins on the long neglected Temple. Masons, stonecutters, carpenters, bronze & iron-workers are hired. When the Temple is beautiful once more, there is still money enough to replace the silver & gold \_\_\_\_ & other items that Joash's wicked grandmother stole for her worship of Baal.
