



"Let it now be known to the king that, if this city is built & the walls completed, they will not pay tax, tribute, or custom, & the king's ____ will be diminished," they wrote. 6. After the Temple was completed, the people dedicated it to God. They ____ the Passover with those who separated themselves in order to serve the Lord God of Israel. 7. Let the work of this house of God alone; let the ____ of the Jews & the elders of the Jews build this house of God on its site. Moreover I issue a decree as to what you shall do for the elders of these Jews, for the building of this house of God: Let the cost be paid at the king's expense from taxes on the region beyond the River; this is to be given immediately to these men, so that they are not hindered" (Ezra 6:7-8, NKJV). 9.
