

- An officer of the Roman army went to seek help from the Jewish leaders. The \_\_\_\_ explained to them that his servant was very sick with the palsy.

- Before He could reach His destination, the Roman officer came & finished his \_\_\_\_ to Jesus himself.
- He knew that Jesus was no ordinary man, & he didn't even feel worthy of a visit from Him. Nevertheless, the centurion's humble message didn't \_\_\_\_ Jesus.

- FTWTF - Power Text
- Immediately Jesus set out for the officer's home. Slowly He made His way on foot through the dense \_\_\_\_\_. But Jesus hadn't gotten very far when the Roman officer's message came to Him, "Lord, do not trouble Yourself, for I am not worthy that You should enter under my roof. Therefore I did not even think myself worthy to come to You" (Luke 7:6, 7).
- Because of that Roman officer's faith, his \_\_\_\_ was blessed with the healing touch of Jesus. Over & over through the years, as long as this story is told, people will learn of the blessings available to each one who comes to Jesus with simple faith, believing in His power to restore human lives.
- FTWTF - Power Text
- [Friday's lesson] Read Mark 10:46-52. Act out the Bible story with your family for worship tonight. How were slaves treated throughout \_\_\_\_? Talk with your family about what it means for people to be slaves to sin. How can we serve & bless people who are still slaves to sin?
- The Jewish leaders promised to help the centurion by carrying his message to Jesus & they hurried off to look for Him. When they found Jesus, "they begged Him earnestly" to help this man, saying "for he loves our nation, & has built us a \_\_\_\_" (Luke 7:4, 5).
- "But say the word, & my servant will be \_\_\_\_\_. For I also am a man placed under authority, having soldiers under me. And I say to one, 'Go,' & he goes; & to another, 'Come,' & he comes; & to my servant, 'Do this,' & he does it" (verses 7, 8).
