1. The \_\_\_\_ of the temple had been laid, so the building of the Temple could now begin.
2. [Wednesday's lesson] Read Ezra 6:1-12. The \_\_\_\_ always wins, but sometimes it takes time. Ask an adult to tell you an experience they had with overcoming discouragement.
3. So the Samaritans tried to discourage the Jews & troubled them as they \_\_\_\_.
4. The Samaritans wrote a letter to King Artaxerxes, accusing the Jews of building a rebellious & evil city. "Let it now be known to the king that, if this city is built & the walls completed, they will not pay tax, tribute, or custom, & the king's \_\_\_\_ will be diminished," they wrote.
5. FTWTF - Power Point
6. After the Temple was completed, the people dedicated it to God. They \_\_\_\_ the Passover with those who separated themselves in order to serve the Lord God of Israel.
7. Let the work of this house of God alone; let the \_\_\_\_ of the Jews & the elders of the Jews build this house of God on its site. Moreover I issue a decree as to what you shall do for the elders of these Jews, for the building of this house of God: Let the cost be paid at the king's expense from taxes on the region beyond the River; this is to be given immediately to these men, so that they are not hindered" (Ezra 6:7-8, NKJV).
8. The Israelites kept the Feast of Unleavened \_\_\_\_ with gladness because the Lord was with them. They recognized that God had changed the heart of the Assyrian king toward them for the better.
9. With grateful \_\_\_\_ the people acknowledged that it was the God of Israel who made their work to prosper & who helped them complete the building of the Temple (see verse 22).

11. But God blessed the Israelites, & they did not \_\_\_\_ until a report could be sent to Darius, inquiring about whether they had permission to keep building.
