# The Story of Job

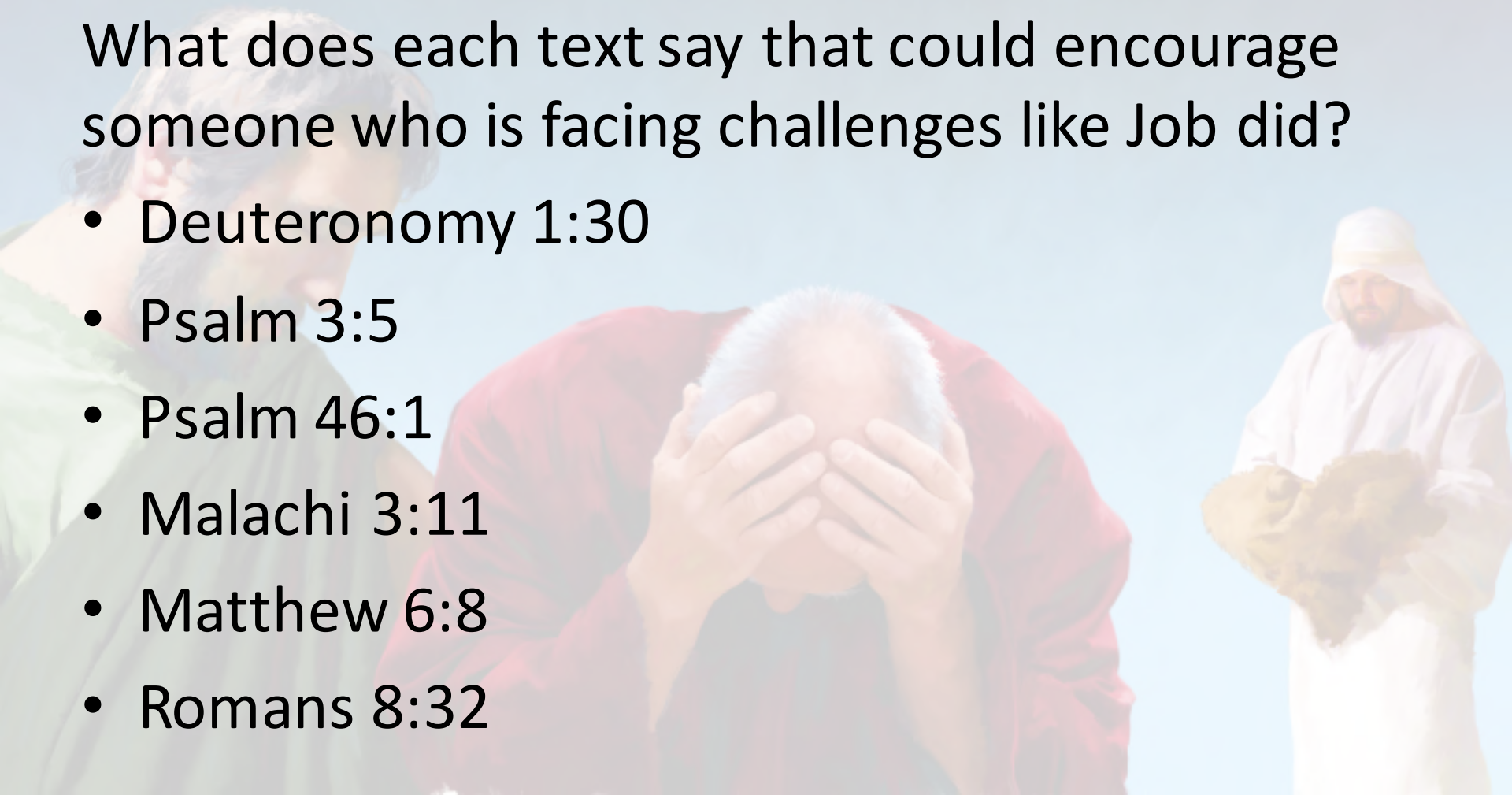
Read the story dramatically from Job 1 and 2.

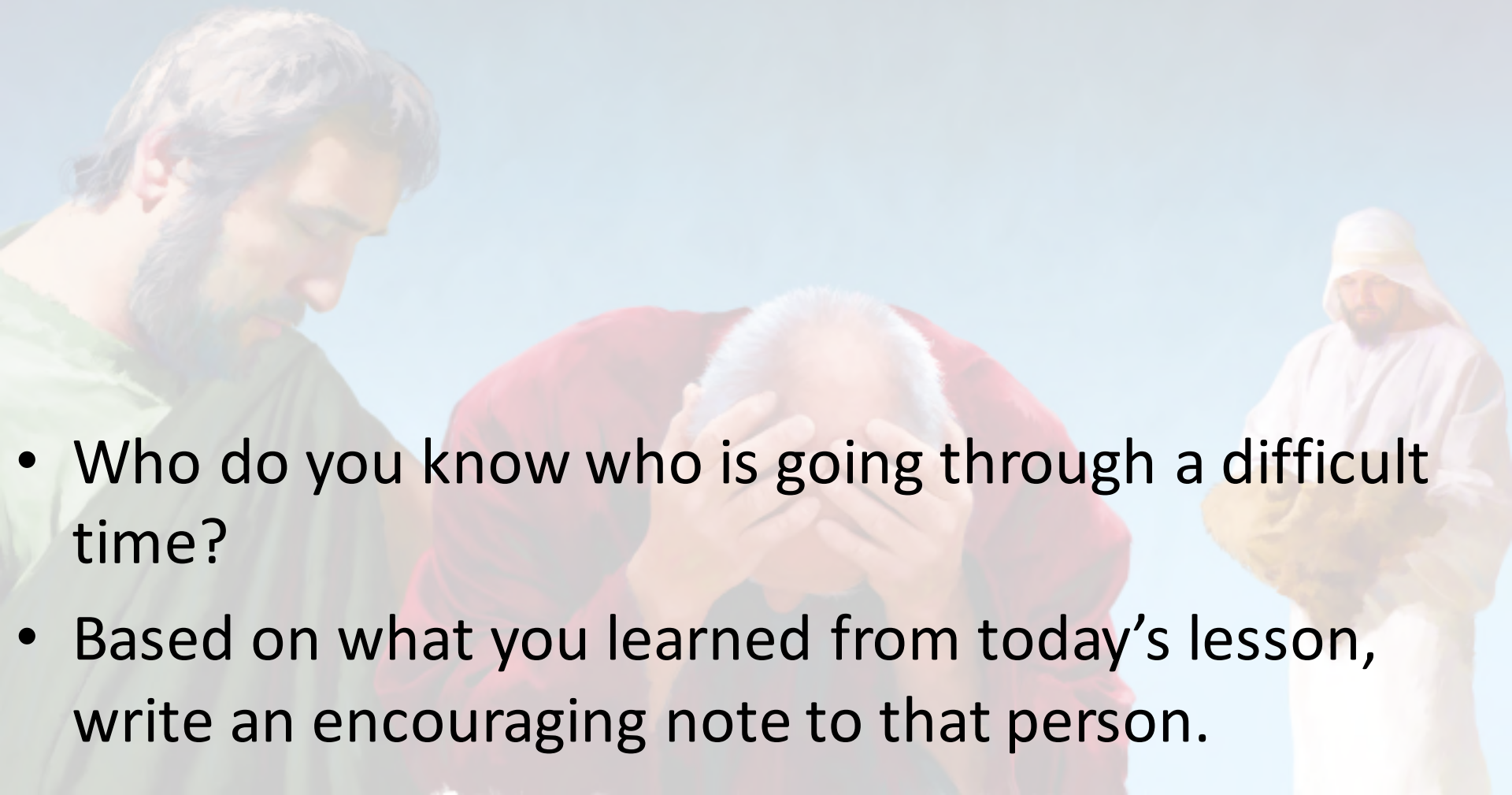

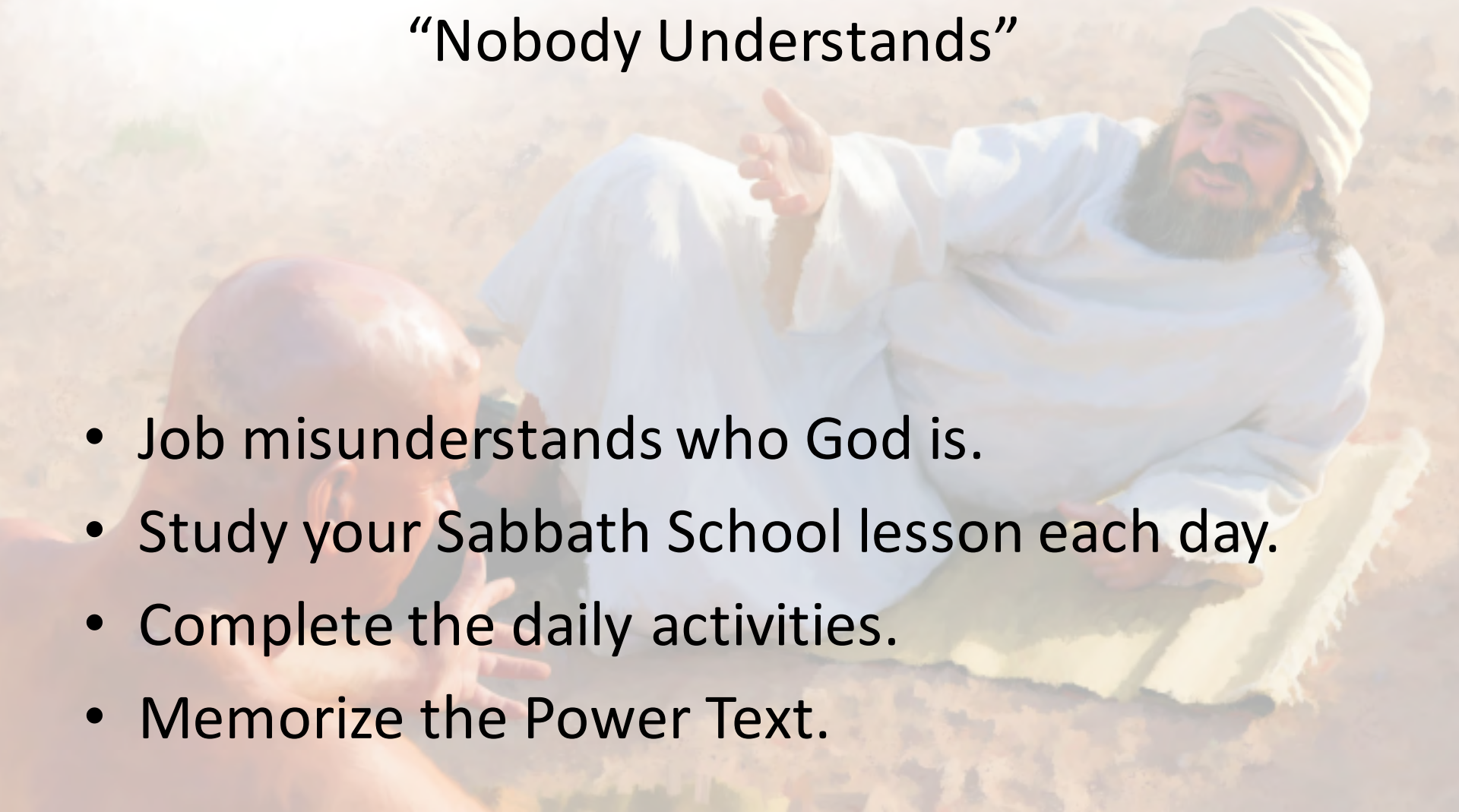
