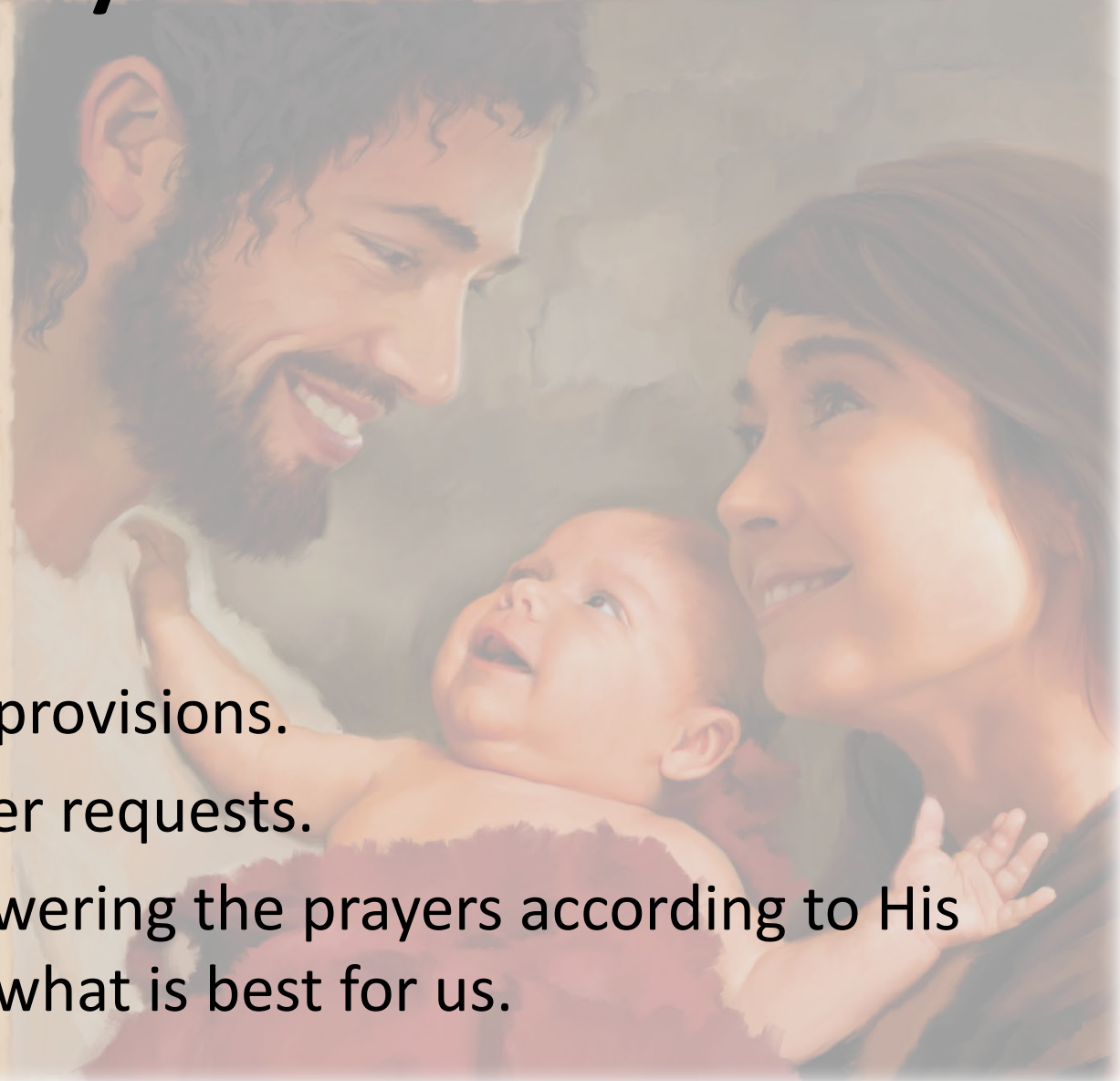
PRAYER AND PRAISE



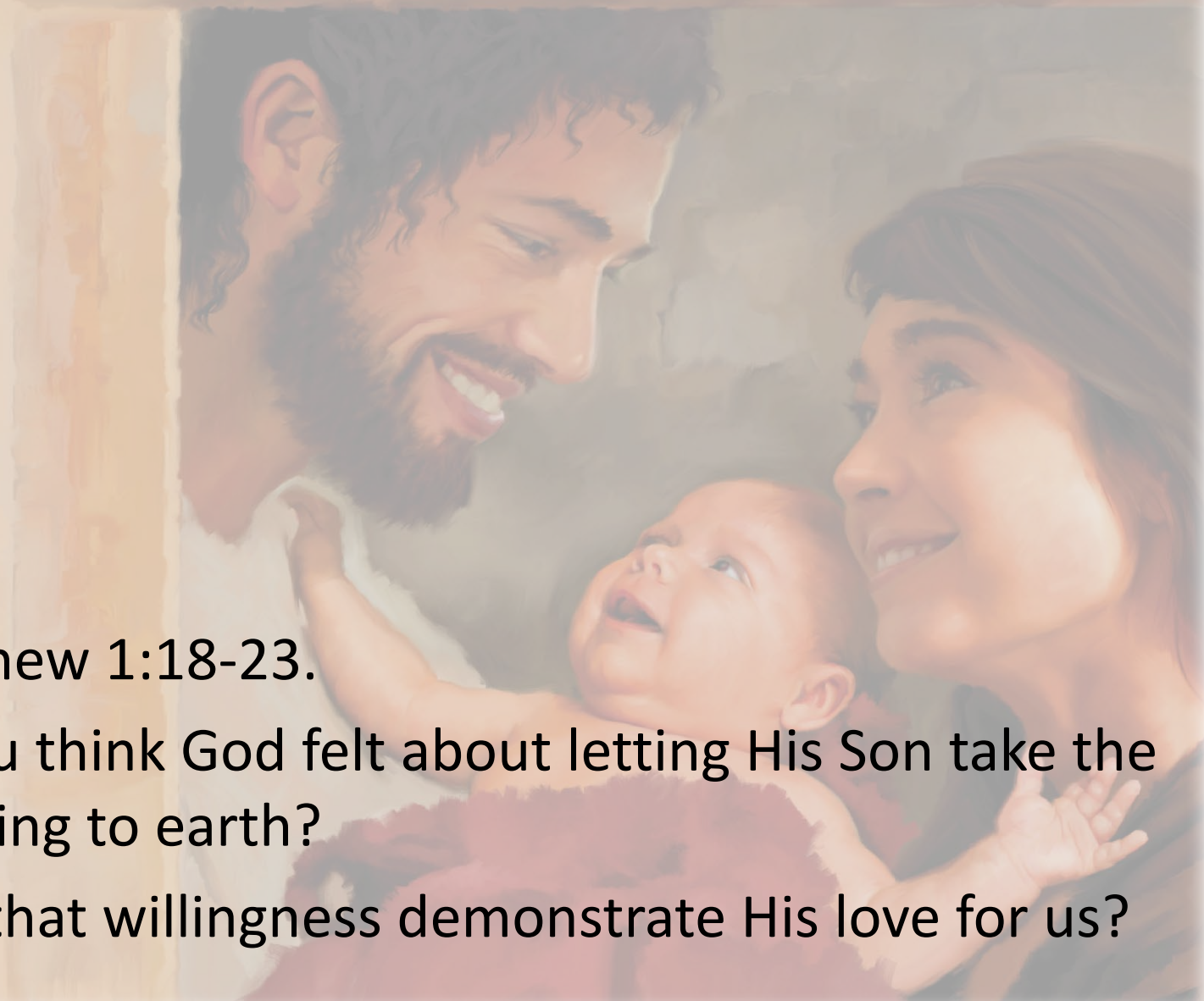
EXPERIENCE THE STORY

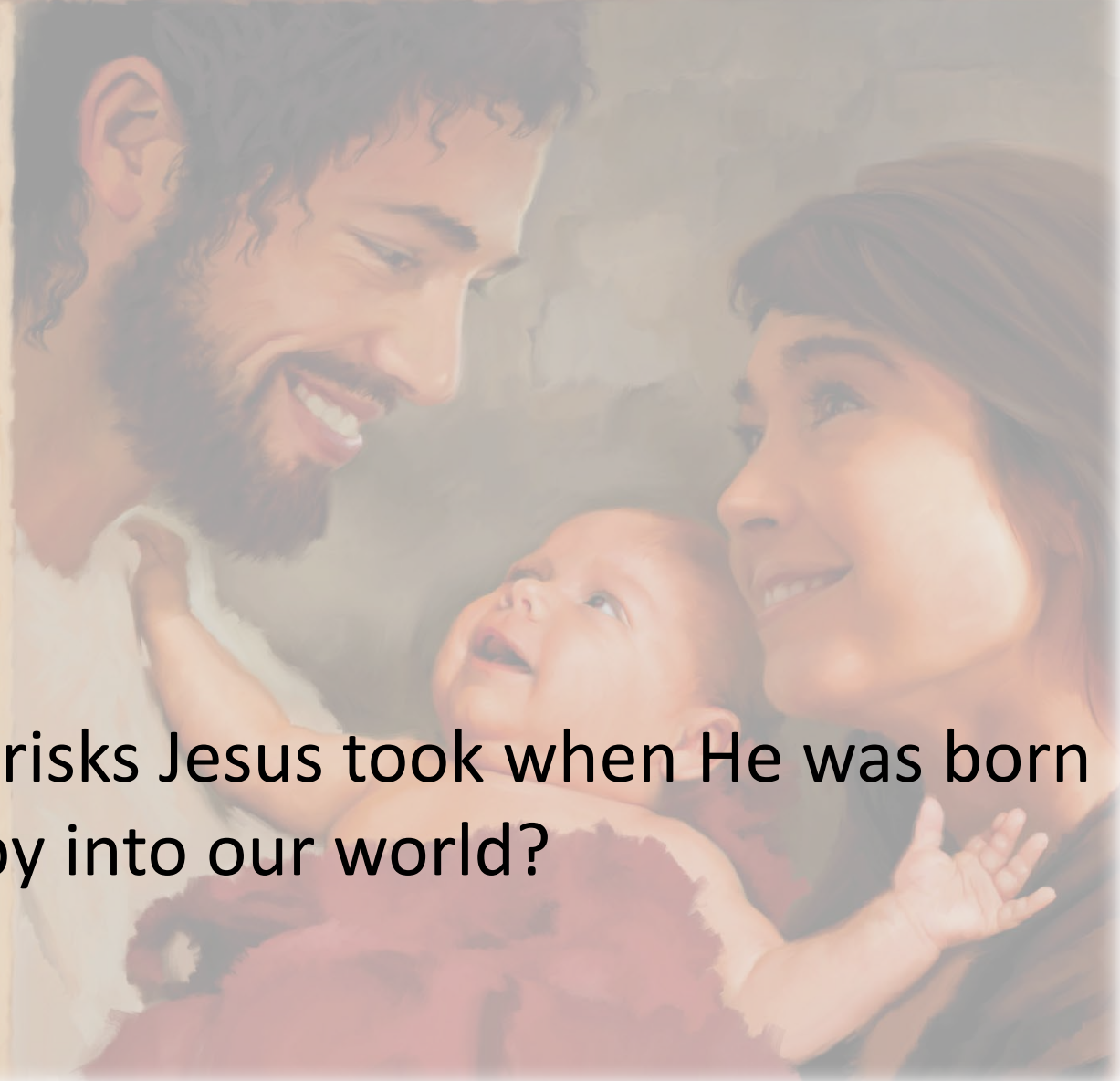



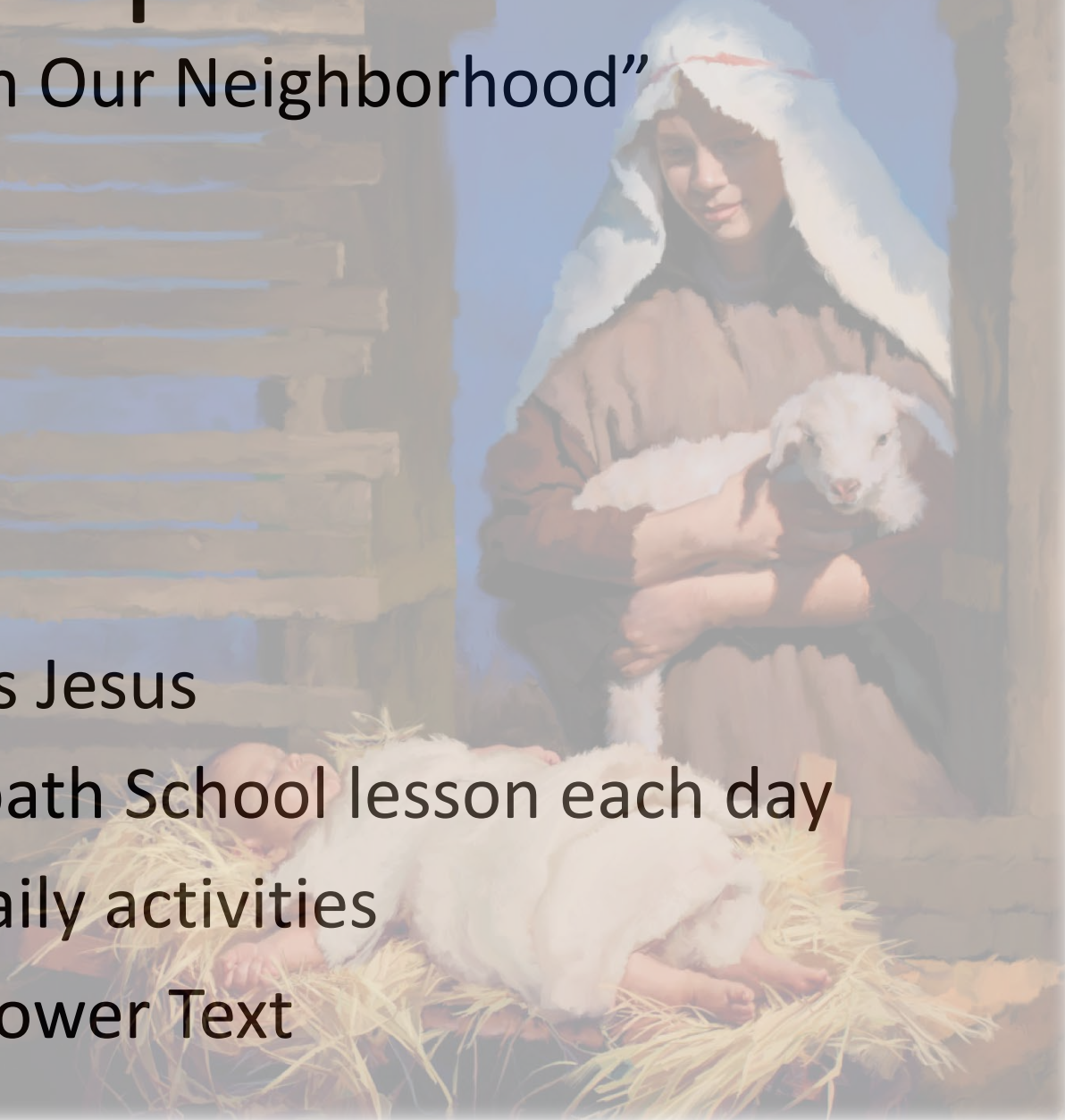
